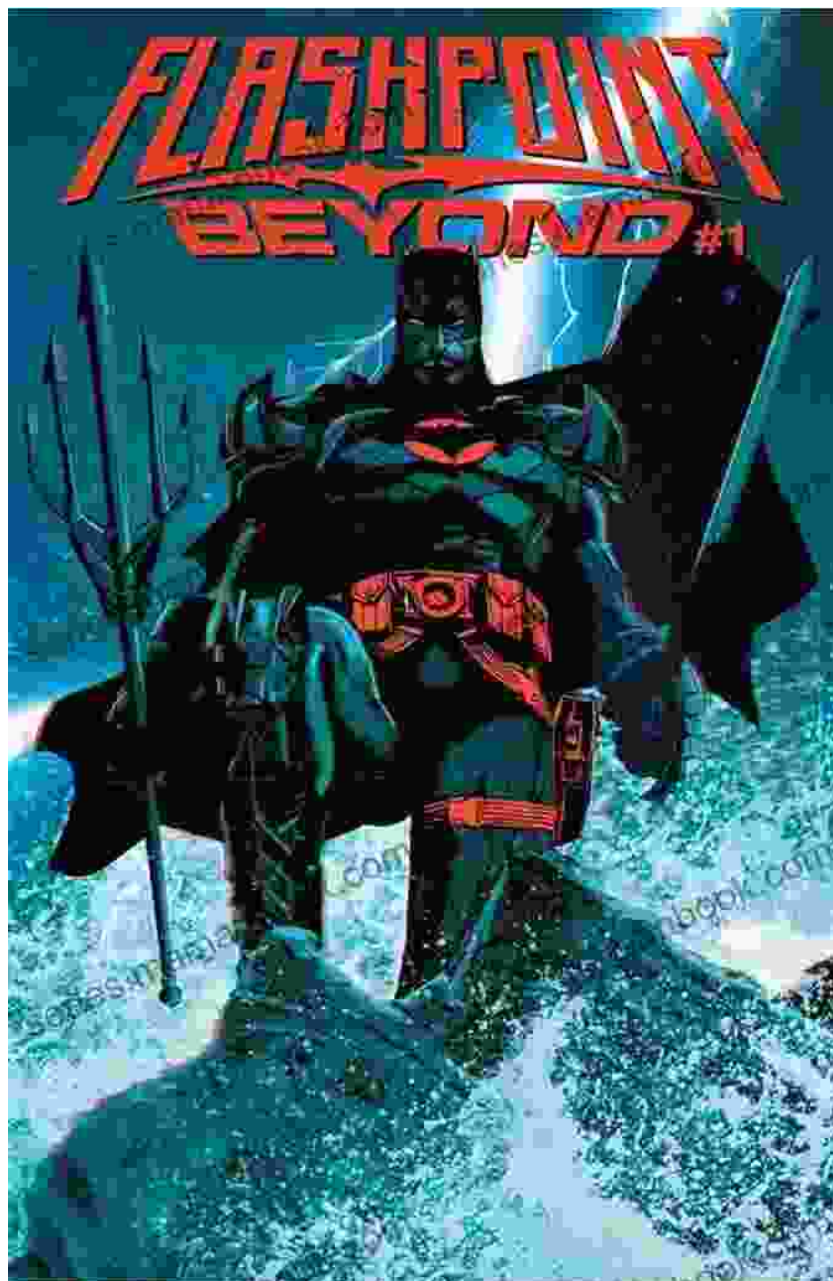


Flashpoint Beyond 2024: Geoff Johns Explores the Possibilities and Challenges of a Post-Flash World

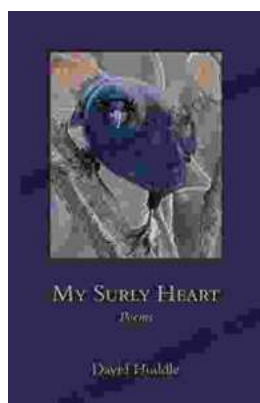
