

 Counts to 100,000 by ones, tens, hundreds, thousands, ten thousands, and hundred thousands.

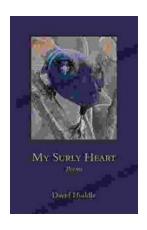
