This easy ribbed beanie and pom-pom hat is perfect for beginners.

Materials

- 1 skein of worsted weight yarn
- US size 7 (4.5mm) knitting needles
- Yarn needle

- Pompom maker (optional)

Gauge

- 20 stitches and 28 rows = 4 inches in stockinette stitch

Instructions

Cast On

1. Cast on 96 stitches using the long tail cast on method.

Ribbing

1. Knit 2, purl 2 for 6 inches.

Decreasing

1. Decrease 12 stitches evenly across the next row. (K2, k2tog, repeat 11 times)
2. Continue decreasing by 12 stitches every other row until there are 24 stitches remaining.

Close Off

1. Thread the yarn needle onto the remaining stitches and pull tight to close off the hat.
2. Weave in any loose ends.

Pompom (Optional)

1. Wrap the yarn around the pompom maker 100 times.
2. Cut the yarn and tie it off securely in the center.

3. Remove the pompom from the maker and trim it to shape.
4. Attach the pompom to the top of the hat.

Finished Size

- Approximately 9 inches tall and 8 inches wide

Tips

- Be sure to check your gauge before starting the hat. If your gauge is off, you may need to adjust the number of stitches you cast on.
- When decreasing, be sure to space the decreases evenly across the row. This will help to create a smooth decrease.
- If you don't have a pompom maker, you can make a pompom by wrapping yarn around a piece of cardboard and then cutting the loops.

Variations

- Change the color of the yarn to create a different look.
- Add a different type of stitch, such as a cable stitch or a lace stitch, to the hat.
- Make the hat longer or shorter by casting on more or less stitches.

Now you can enjoy the warmth and style of a handmade hat all winter long.

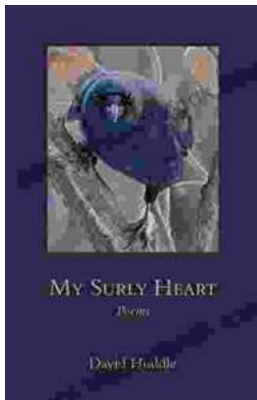
